## **IOM Helsinki AVR Update February 2006**

### **Assistance to Returnees at the IOM Chisinau Rehabilitation Centre**

IOM Helsinki hereby forwards you some material on the IOM Chisinau Rehabilitation Centre for your information. The Rehabilitation Centre's services are also available for vulnerable persons returning, amongst others, from Denmark, Finland or Sweden to Moldova.

The IOM Chisinau Rehabilitation Centre is often the first contact point in Moldova for trafficked persons returning home. The Centre provides assistance and temporary shelter to adults, adolescents and younger children. During the stay at the shelter, residents can benefit from a range of "in-house" services: medical, psychological, social, legal, educational and recreational.

The Rehabilitation Centre is open to trafficked persons and their children, unaccompanied minors, and individuals at risk of trafficking.

For Assisted Voluntary Returns to Moldova through IOM Helsinki, IOM Helsinki will coordinate and arrange arrival assistance and possible referral to the Centre with the IOM Office in Chisinau.

Please find included with this message two brochures on the services of the IOM Chisinau Rehabilitation Centre:

1. **English-language brochure** (for local authorities/IOM counterparts)
2. **Romanian/Russian-language brochure** (for Moldovan migrants)

The two brochures are not identical. The English-language brochure reaches out to IOM counterparts, whereas the Romanian/Russian-language brochure targets Moldovan migrants.

If you would like to receive printed copies of the brochures for distribution at as for example reception centres, immigration authorities or NGOs working with trafficked persons, kindly contact IOM Helsinki and inform of the number of needed copies of each brochure as well as an address to which the brochures can be sent. IOM Helsinki can also be contacted for further information on voluntary returns to Moldova.
